Congolese musician General Defao has been remanded at Industrial Area Prison after he failed to secure a Sh200,000 bond with two Kenyan

The king of "Kiwanzenza" dancing tyle, described by his lawyers as having a "fanatical" following in Kenya, is facng Sh594,400 fraud charges.

Mr Miller told the court that it was unfair for Mr. Kemboi to say that his client had no fixed abode, adding that Defactwas an international entertainer who could not jump bail.

The other members of the band were being investigated and might be charged together with Defao, Mr Kemboi had earlier told the court.
